### DWC TERTIARY SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED

The 2025 DWC Tertiary Scholarships have been awarded to Elyse Johnson, Harrison Whittaker, Iris Reynolds, Jake Priebe, and Niko Barnett, recognising their exceptional academic achievements, leadership qualities, and commitment to their communities.

DWC's annual scholarships, valued at up to \$32,500 per student, aim to support West Coast youth by removing barriers to tertiary education and encouraging them to return to the region after their studies. In addition to financial support, the scholarships offer summer work placements and guaranteed employment on the West Coast upon graduation.
