- 5.5 hrs apart → alternate options if plans shift

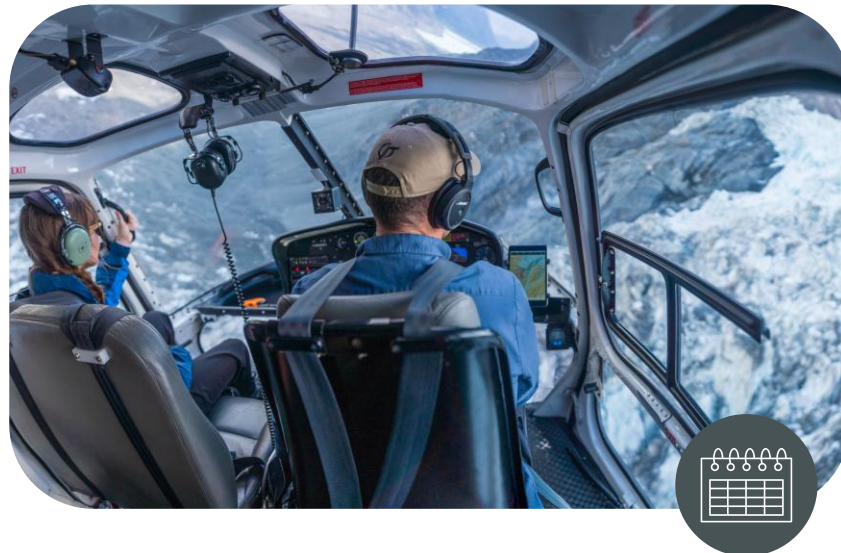

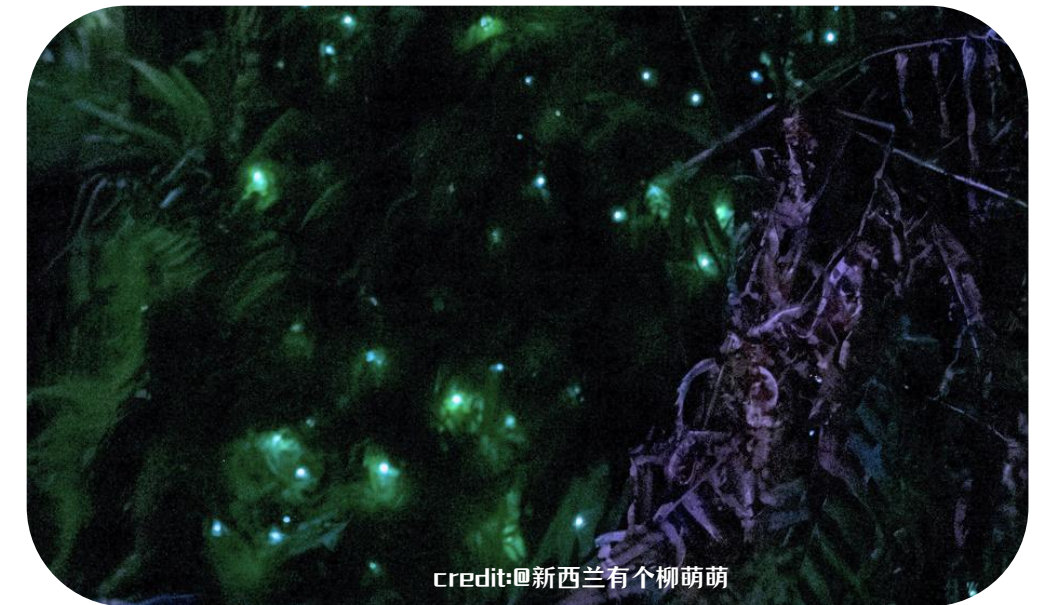
 Te Kopikopiko o te Waka (Peak View)
